Tester reports – The engine started readily from cold & hot & ran well, happily sitting at 45 to 50 mph, though there was some mechanical noise at lower revs. The clutch operated without fault. All the gears selected cleanly & functioned normally. Both period brakes worked with the rear being better than the front, which juddered slightly.
