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Tester reports – The engine started readily from cold & when hot. The motor pulled strongly managing the tall gearing well. The carburettor felt a little lean just above tick over. The clutch worked without fault & all the gears selected & functioned normally. Both period brakes worked with the rear being better than the front, which may bed in with use. The motorcycle steered & handled nicely, making for an enjoyable Italian machine to test ride!
