Tester reports – Started readily from cold & hot. The engine ran well, was happy to rev & sat happily at 50 mph. The clutch worked well after it had been allowed to free off when first started, which only took a few seconds. The gears selected & functioned normally. Both period brakes worked well. The bike steered & handled nicely, just as a Velocette should!
