Tester reports – The motor started readily both hot & cold & ran very well happily pulling the tall gearing, stomping along at 60-65mph. The Newby clutch was light & operated without fault. All the gears selected & operated normally. Both period brakes worked as well as you would expect. The steering & handling were good with this late model Inter being fun to road test!
