Tester reports – The engine was low on compression so was started on our rolling road starter & ran quite well with no nasty mechanical noises. Once warmed up the engine breathed a bit. The clutch worked without fault. All the gears selected & functioned normally. Both the period brakes worked, with the front being toe better of the two. The bike steered & handled as you would expect.
