Tester reports – Started readily from cold & when hot. The motor well, happily sitting at 50 mph, though there was a little smoke on start-up. The clutch was light & worked well. All the gears selected & functioned normally. Both period brakes worked as well as you would expect. The bike steered & handled nicely.
