Tester reports – Started readily from cold & when hot. The engine ran very well, was mechanically quiet & pulled strongly from low revs. The clutch worked without fault. All gears selected & functioned normally. Both period brakes worked, with the front being better than the rear, which should improve with use. The bike steered & handled nicely, a pleasant classic motorcycle.
